

**Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C**  
**Adams Morgan**  
**Minutes of April 4, 2018**

**I. Call to Order and Introduction of the Commissioners**

A regularly scheduled meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C was held on April 4, 2018 at Mary's Center. Chair Hector Huezo called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. About 20 members of the public attended. In attendance were Commissioners Hector Huezo (1C02), Ted Guthrie (1C03), Wilson Reynolds (1C07), and Amanda Fox Perry (1C08).

**II. Officers' Reports**

**a. Chair's Report**

Chair Huezo noted that there was a lack of a quorum and therefore no votes could be taken.

**III. Commissioner Announcements**

- Commissioner Fox Perry announced that the Public Services and the Environment Committee would will hear about renovation plans for Walter Pierce Park at its April 25 meeting.
- Commissioner Reynolds reported that he and former Commissioner Gambrell testified before the City Council's Committee of the Whole on March 20 on proposed amendments to DC's Comprehensive Plan.
- Commissioner Guthrie suggested that matters listed under the Planning, Zoning, and Transportation Committee section of tonight's agenda be moved to the April 18 PZT Committee meeting. Commissioner Huezo noted that the Public Services and the Environment matters could be moved to the May 2 full ANC meeting.

**IV. Public Announcements / Comments**

- A representative from the District Department of Transportation announced that a public meeting would be held to discuss a streetscape project for Connecticut Avenue including a deck and a public plaza over the underpass near Dupont Circle. She encouraged members of the public to come to the meeting on Thursday, April 26 at WeWork Dupont, and to go to the website to learn more and to leave comments.
- Alan Gambrell complimented DDOT and the contractors who replaced the sidewalks in Lanier Heights for their quick work and for replacing the tree boxes with bigger ones.
- Benedicte Aubrun of the Reed Cooke Neighborhood Association reported on the Comprehensive Plan hearing and asked about ANC 1C's position on Planned Unit Developments (PUDs).
- A representative from Mayor Bowser's office announced events for Emancipation Day on April 14 and provided copies of the Mayor's latest newsletter with other updates. She encouraged the public to contact the Mayor's Office of Community Relations and Services for more information.
- A representative from Councilmember Nadeau's office announced an upcoming public safety meeting on April 25; the next Brienne on Your Block meeting on April 30 at Sheba Café; and, three upcoming constituent services walks in April.
- Kristen Barden, of the Adams Morgan BID, reported that movies in the park would be returning to the Marie Reed field starting on Tuesday, May 15.
