Minutes of October 2, 2002, Meeting

SECRETARY'S REPORT

*ANC 1C RESOLUTION REGARDING PARKING LOT AT
CORNER OF COLUMBIA ROAD NW

WHEREAS, the parking lot at the corner of Columbia Road NW and Biltmore Street NW in Adams Morgan has been a concern for its residential neighbors; and

WHEREAS, half of said lot is on public space; and

WHEREAS, any decisions by the DC government about the disposition and uses of said lot would be and are of significant interest to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 1C opposes any final action(s) or decision(s) regarding said lot (including the granting of any permits) until a notification of proposed actions or permits is made in writing to this ANC and a discussion by this ANC about such actions or permits is concluded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this ANC shall include this topic on the agenda of its October 2002 forum for community discussion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution and a cover letter from this ANC be faxed to the DC Department of Consumer and Regularity Affairs when the agency opens Thursday, October 3, 2002.

Commissioner Wright offered a motion dealing with the establishment of Emergency Preparedness Week. The motion was seconded, debated and approved by roll call vote:

The approved motion reads:

ANC 1C RESOLUTION CALLING FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF "D.C. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS WEEK"

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia government has launched a citywide emergency preparedness neighborhood planning process; and

WHEREAS, effective emergency preparedness involves coordination between government agencies, neighborhoods, businesses, families and individuals; and

WHEREAS, while neighborhood and citywide planning efforts will be ongoing, family and individual preparedness will be enhanced by establishing an annual period during which D.C. residents are reminded about the steps they can take to prepare for emergencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C requests the Mayor and Council of the District of Columbia to proclaim the calendar week prior to September 11 as D.C. Emergency Preparedness Week, during which public attention will be focused on grassroots emergency preparedness; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC 1C shall send a letter to Del. Eleanor Holmes Norton requesting her to urge the National Safety Council (chartered by the United States Congress in 1953 as the nation's leading advocate for safety and health) to change its Preparedness Week - currently part of its "National Safety Month" - from June to September, in order to reinforce on a national basis each American's attention to emergency preparedness.

Commissioner Gibson moved to adjourn. The motion to adjourn was seconded and approved by voice vote.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 pm.
