

**ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 1C  
Adams Morgan**

**Minutes of December 4, 2002, Meeting**

A scheduled Business meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C was held on December 4, 2002, at the 3rd District Police Station. A quorum being present, Chair Miscuk called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Attending were Commissioners Roth, Wright, Miscuk, Jovanka, Johnson, Bailey Gibson, Brody and Klempay. Approximately 10 members of the public attended.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Commissioner Brody moved that ANC 1C approve the voluntary agreement with San Diego Sushi. The motion was seconded, debated and approved by roll call vote:

Commissioner Miscuk, Commissioner Wright presiding, offered a resolution protesting renewal of Cassava Café's ABC License. The motion was seconded, debated and approved by roll call vote:

The approved motion reads:

***ANC 1C RESOLUTION PROTESTING RENEWAL  
OF CASSAVA CAFÉ'S ABC LICENSE***

*WHEREAS, the establishment known as TYDKA, Inc. t/a Cassava Café, located at 2411 18<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., has applied for renewal of its Class CT ABC license (Application No. 25263) and*

*WHEREAS, said establishment is located within the jurisdiction of ANC 1C, and*

*WHEREAS, since the time of said establishment's last renewal application ANC 1C has had pending a protest to such renewal on the grounds of the establishment's adverse effects on peace, order, and quiet in the*

*community, which protest was carried by ANC 1C to a full evidentiary hearing spanning two days, and*

*WHEREAS, such protest has not yet been decided by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board,*

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 1C again protests the renewal of said establishment's ABC license on the grounds of its adverse effects on peace, order, and quiet in the community, including all the same grounds and evidence on which the pending undecided protest was based, and be it further*

*RESOLVED, that ANC 1C respectfully requests the ABC Board to issue its decision on the evidence in the pending undecided protest before requiring any further status hearings or other proceedings in the current renewal cycle.*

#### TREASURER'S REPORT

Commissioner Gibson, Treasurer, reported a bank balance as of 12/04/02 of \$43,633.71.

Commissioner Miscuk reported that the grant to Emmaus Services for the Aging, which was approved by ANC 1C at the November 18, 2002 meeting, has been rejected by the Office or Corporate Counsel. Commissioner Roth moved that ANC 1C protest the Corporate Counsel decision rejecting the grant and requesting that the Mayor, the Office of ANC Commissioners and counsel members seek further explanation and reconsideration from Corporate Counsel. The motion was seconded and approved by roll call vote:
