Suspect Sought in Two Burglary Offenses in the Third District

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department’s Third District seek the public’s assistance in locating a suspect in reference to two Burglary offenses that occurred in the Third District.

- On Monday, December 10, 2018, at approximately 1:40 pm, the suspect entered an unoccupied residence in the 2200 block of 19th Street, Northwest. Once inside, the suspect took property and fled the scene. **Burglary Two CCN: 18-210-222**
- On Sunday, January 6, 2019, at approximately 12:00 pm, two suspects entered an occupied residence in the 1700 block of Lanier Place, Northwest. Once inside, the suspects took property and fled the scene. **Burglary One CCN: 19-003-497**

One of the suspects, identified as **27-year-old Travis Tito Brandon**, is currently wanted on a DC Superior Court arrest warrant in reference to these cases. Brandon is described as a black male, medium complexion, approximately 6’4” tall, approximately 200 pounds, with a tattoo of a spider on his left forearm. He can be seen in the photos below:
