Resolution on temporary amendments to Settlement Agreements for World Cup 2022

Whereas, the 2022 World Cup Football Tournament is scheduled for November 20 to December 18, 2022; and

Whereas, due to the time difference with the host nation of Qatar some games will be aired beginning at 4:00 am ET; and

Whereas, many ABC establishments including class "C" establishments within the boundaries of ANC 1C have Settlement Agreements with ANC 1C that either limit and/or state the hours of operation; and

Whereas, the DC City Council has recently approved emergency, temporary legislation that allows class "C" establishments to remain open 24 hours per day throughout the World Cup 2022 tournament.

Therefore Be It Resolved, that ANC 1C agrees to temporarily amend all existing Settlement Agreements that limit hours to enable establishments to open for the World Cup 2022 games as follows:

November 21 - 4am Senegal vs Netherlands
November 22 - 4am Argentina vs Saudi Arabia
November 23 - 4am Morocco vs Croatia
November 24 - 4am Switzerland vs Cameroon
November 25 - 4am Wales vs Iran
November 26 - 4am Tunisia vs Australia
November 27 - 4am Japan vs Costa Rica
November 28 - 4am Cameroon vs Serbia

Alcohol service can begin at 6 am between November 20 and December 18, 2022, for World Cup 2022 viewing.

The following conditions also apply:

1. Establishments must register with the DC ABC Board and the Metropolitan Police Department to participate in the additional privileges allowed under DC Council Temporary Legislation, the "2022 World Cup Emergency Amendment Act of 2022".
2. This temporary amendment does not apply to any outdoor seating areas, whether Summer Gardens, Sidewalk Cafes, or Streateries.
