Resolution for Adams Morgan Day 2016

In 2015, a group of volunteers consisting of Adams Morgan residents and local business owners organized to save Adams Morgan Day. They revised the event to make it a celebration of Adams Morgan's neighbors, businesses, artists, history, and culture. The event was smaller than in recent years, but it was a great success because of its renewed focus on neighborhood participation and grassroots organizing. It was a true celebration of Adams Morgan.

In 2016, local volunteers are again organizing Adams Morgan Day along these same lines, while endeavoring to formalize their efforts to better interact with District government agencies. ANC1C supports these efforts and:

-ANC1C calls on the Mayor's Office, the Ward 1 Councilmember's Office, and all District agencies working with the Adams Morgan Day 2016 volunteers to do their utmost to assist these volunteers to succeed in their efforts, to avoid imposing undue costs for the day, or where costs are unavoidable, to find ways to assist in offsetting those costs (for example, with grants, etc.).

-ANC1C specifically notifies ABRA and the ABC Board that ANC1C agrees to relax its settlement agreements with all Adams Morgan licensees for the date of September 11, 2016, from 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm only, in the following respects:

- ABC licensees may provide entertainment inside their establishments;
- ABC licensees may keep their doors and windows open;
- ABC licensees may allow sound to project from inside their establishments onto the sidewalk and street.

These permissions shall only be allowed from 12:00 pm ending at 6:00 pm on September 11, 2016.
