**ANC1C Resolution for the Construction Traffic Management Plan for the Modernization of the Marie H. Reed Community Learning Center**

ANC 1C does support the closing of that stretch of Champlain Street adjacent to the school grounds from the intersection of Kalorama Road to the intersection of Old Morgan School Place, hereafter referred to as the "Champlain stretch".

ANC1C has serious concerns about truck routes and is awaiting further clarifications.

ANC1C calls for flag crews to be required.

ANC1C calls on DDOT to require that security personnel be present when construction is not occurring.

ANC1C calls on DDOT to keep the sidewalk open on 18th Street on evenings and weekends after construction hours to the extent consistent with public safety.
