At a duly-noticed public meeting held on 7/7/2021, with a quorum present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C passed a resolution by a vote of 7-0-0 supporting Monica Jahan Bose's DCCAHA Public Art Building Communities Grant application for Sustain, a temporary public art project in Adams Morgan.

Monica Jahan Bose has requested from ANC 1C a letter of support for Sustain, a proposed temporary public art project in Adams Morgan, to be presented at the facade of the Line Hotel, 1770 Euclid St NW, Washington, DC 20009, and across the street along Unity Park in spring 2022.

Ms. Bose presented her project plan to the Public Services and Environment committee on June 23rd and presented the project to the full ANC on July 7th. The project will involve temporary fabric installations, a soundscape, and video screening. Ms. Bose is also seeking approval and coordination with the other relevant neighborhood stakeholders including the Adams Morgan Business Improvement District, the Line Hotel, and the Department of Parks and Recreation.

ANC 1C previously supported Ms. Bose's prior project in Adams Morgan, Concrete Dreams, which was well received and welcomed by the community. We would be pleased to have her create another public art piece in Adams Morgan next year and support her application for a DCCAHA Public Art Building
