Minutes of June 20, 2006

A quarterly public forum meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C was held on Tuesday, June 20, 2006 at Mary's Center. Chairperson Alan Roth called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm. Approximately 15 members of the public attended the meeting.

Commissioners in attendance were: Alan Roth (1C01), Bryan Weaver (1C03), Mindy Moretti (1C04), Andy Miscuk (1C05), and Wilson Reynolds (1C07).

Commissioner Moretti introduced the topic of the forum – “The Parks of Adams Morgan: Walter Pierce, Kalorama, Marie Reed Field, and Our Small Triangle and Pocket Parks” – and the speakers for the evening.

Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) Kimberly Flowers, Deputy Director for Operations Johnel Bracey, Capital Projects Community Coordinator Jackie Stanley, Director of Partnerships Kay Sibetta, Landscape Architect Sharon Dendy, Wards 1-4 Planner Tanya Washington, and Special Assistant for Community Affairs Bob King all described their respective areas of responsibility and discussed issues and projects on which they had been working in Adams Morgan.

The floor was then opened for a discussion session lasting approximately 1 hour, during which Commissioners and members of the public were recognized to ask questions and to offer their views, comments, etc. on general DPR issues and specific Adams Morgan park issues. In addition to the Commissioners present at the meeting, members of the public who spoke or asked questions included Carter Rabasa of the Washington Area Kickball Association, Jamal Najjab of the Fund for Kalorama Park, Kalorama Citizens Association President Denis James, Lanier Heights resident Karen Smith, Kalorama Triangle resident Eddie Becker, and Tony Harvey of the InTowner.
