

Jubilee JumpStart – ANC Grant Request 2016

Jubilee JumpStart, a non-profit early childhood development center in Adams Morgan, provides high-quality early education services for 48 children ages 6 weeks through 5 years of age. Jubilee JumpStart prepares children from low-income families for success in school and life. We provide a high-quality, evidence-based program, focused on social and emotional well-being, in partnership with families and the community. Our vision is a just and compassionate society in which children of all social and economic backgrounds receive the loving care, early education, and diverse social experiences they need to reach their highest potential and contribute to the common good.

Jubilee JumpStart is characterized by a dynamic learning environment in a dual-language (English and Spanish) setting, highly trained and educated staff, parent education and support, research-based curriculum, and intensive individualized instruction. Combined, these program elements contribute to Jubilee JumpStart's overarching goal that the children we serve are ready to succeed in kindergarten and beyond, and that their parents have the tools they need to enhance their effectiveness as caregivers during this critical developmental period in their children's lives.

Jubilee JumpStart uses the Creative Curriculum, a research-based curriculum, which assesses children's progress in four areas -- emotional, physical, cognitive, and language -- using its GOLD developmental assessment tool. Jubilee JumpStart's objective is that 48 children ages birth to 5 will demonstrate levels of aptitude appropriate to the child's age and/or developmental stage in objectives for development and learning in three out of the four areas: social-emotional, physical, oral language, and cognitive development. By achieving these objectives, children will be ready to learn and perform in school.

In order to achieve this objective, our teachers need the tools to be able to effectively use the Creative Curriculum and assess children. Jubilee JumpStart has three suites with a total of five classrooms and employs 22 full and part time teachers and assistant teachers. Currently, the center only has one laptop per suite for teachers to research and write lesson plans, complete student assessments, communicate with parents, and participate in professional development activities. Having additional computers readily available will allow more teachers to utilize the technology necessary to better serve children and parents.

We plan on putting the ANC grant money towards the cost of three new laptops for the center. Below is an itemized list of what we would use the ANC Grant for:
